

The Real Deal

- A guide to setting up a project

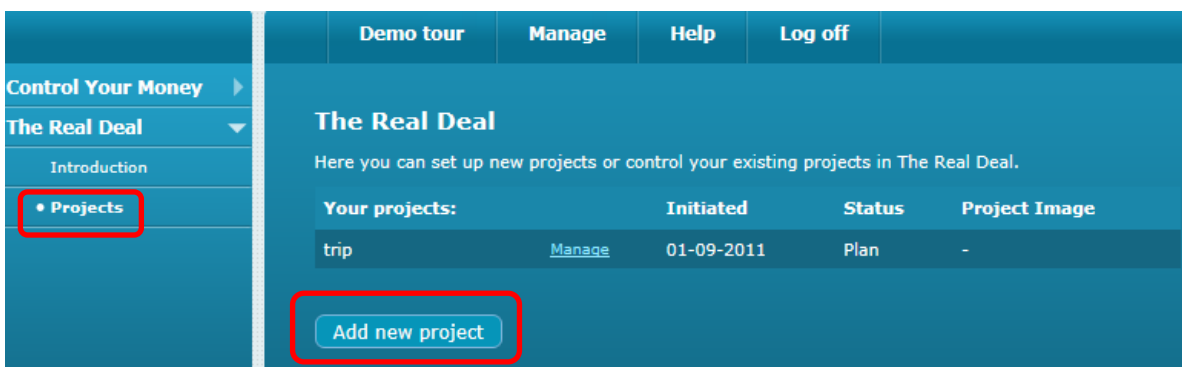
You first have to register in the Teachers' section to access and use the teaching tools. When you are registered as a teacher, you can set up new projects and control your existing projects in *The Real Deal*.

Here is a step-by-step guide to setting up and completing a project in *The Real Deal*.

1. When you have signed up as a teacher in the Teachers' section, you can choose whether you want to work with *Control Your Money* or *The Real Deal*. Select *The Real Deal*.



2. Set up a new project in *The Real Deal* by choosing Projects under *The Real Deal* menu.



3. Name the project and write the name of the class working on the project. If you wish to set up more than one group, you can write your pupils' names under each project. A username and password is automatically generated for the groups, but you can change the suggested login details. Remember to read and accept the terms of publishing before you continue.

Please note that if you wish to go through *The Real Deal* before you introduce it to your pupils, you will need to set up a project for yourself in the Teachers' section – just as when you set up a project for your pupils.

4. You have now set up a project in *The Real Deal*. You can go to *The Real Deal* from the front page of *Control Your Money*.
5. Click Go and login with your username and password.



6. *The Real Deal* consists of two phases. The first phase is a planning phase where the pupils set a goal for their project, find ways to raise money and make a budget.
7. In the second project phase the pupils can update their expenses and income if any changes occur during the project. In a bar chart the pupils can get an overview of their planned and actual budgets. Use the diagram to discuss when the pupils have reached their goal.
8. When the project is completed, the pupils can share their experiences and tell their story. Please note that the project name, starting amount as well as the planned and actual budget are visible to other visitors at www.controlyourmoney.co.uk/therealdeal.

Important: If the pupils have uploaded a photo to their project, you must approve it before it appears on the site. Below the project list, you can see if a photo awaits your approval. We ask for your approval for the upload of images in order that you can apply your school's policy in relation to child protection and parental permission for children to be photographed.
